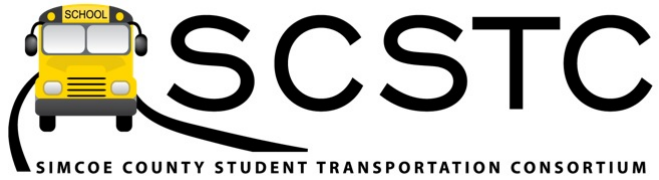

Rationale	The Simcoe County Student Transportation Consortium (SCSTC) policy for Duration of Bus Trip provides the guidelines for determining the duration of home-to-school bus trips for eligible students.				
Policy	It is the policy of the SCSTC to follow member district school boards' policies and procedures relating to the duration of a home to school bus trip.				
Overview	<p>Duration of one-way home to school bus trips will correspond as near to and as is practical to the following:</p> <table style="margin-left: 40px;"> <tr> <td>JK to Grade 8</td> <td>60 minutes</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Grades 9 to 12</td> <td>75 minutes</td> </tr> </table> <p>The duration of the bus trip is calculated based on the time the student is travelling on the bus one-way.</p> <p>The duration of the bus trip is calculated based on normal conditions and does not take into account any external factors such as: differing traffic conditions, construction, weather related delays, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The above ride times do not include the time it takes to load or un-load students in the morning or afternoon. ▪ The above ride times do not apply to program transportation. <p><u>Note:</u> Geographic circumstances such as physical distance from school, road networks, etc., may result in extended duration of bus trips and student ride times.</p>	JK to Grade 8	60 minutes	Grades 9 to 12	75 minutes
