Rationale	The Simcoe County Student Transportation Consortium (SCSTC) policy for Transportation of Co-op Students provides the guidelines used for transportation of co-op students.
Policy	It is the policy of the SCSTC to follow member district school boards' policies and procedures relating to the provision of transportation to co-op students.
Overview	<p>Transportation may be granted for a co-op student if a seat is available on the school vehicle, and there is no variance in the route.</p> <p>SCSTC will create an additional stop location provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ there is no variance to the existing route path; ▪ there is no incremental cost; and ▪ there is no existing stop within a reasonable walk distance to the co-op placement.
