Type: Responsibilities	Date (Revised): June 23, 2014

Rationale	The Simcoe County Student Transportation Consortium (SCSTC) recognizes that all students deserve a safe and positive environment for home-to-school transportation. Students are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner and acknowledge the Principal’s authority that extends to the school vehicle.
Policy	It is the responsibility of home-to-school transported students to behave in accordance with the SCSTC and its member district school boards policies and procedures related to the code of conduct for home-to-school transported students.
Overview	<p>The school vehicle is an extension of the classroom, and as such, student discipline falls under the responsibility of the school Principal. Students are expected to demonstrate the same conduct on the school vehicle as in the classroom. A failure to comply with these expectations may result in a suspension or termination of transportation privileges. It could also lead to further discipline according to the Disciplinary Action policy for the student’s respective school board.</p> <p>Serious or repeated misconduct will be recorded and the report may be placed in the Ontario Student Report folder.</p> <p>Students must adhere to SCSTC and its member district school boards’ policies and procedures as they relate to home-to-school transportation.</p>
