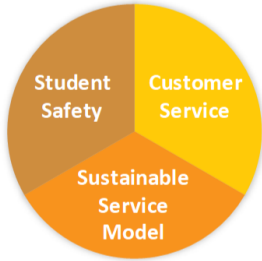

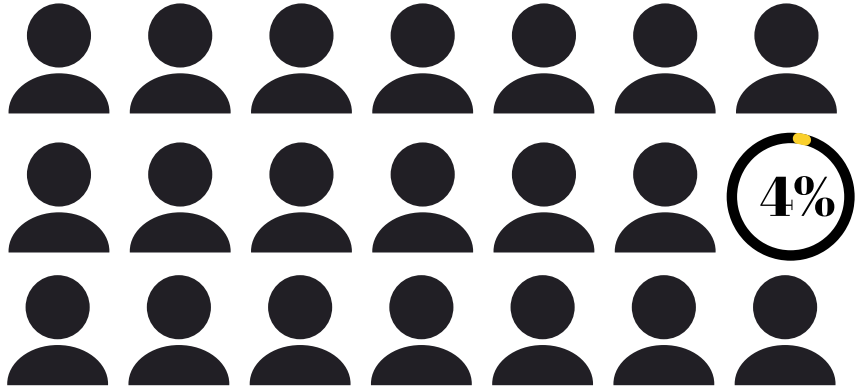
Year in Review

A visual glance at twelve months of hard work and commitment to improving home-to-school transportation in Simcoe County.



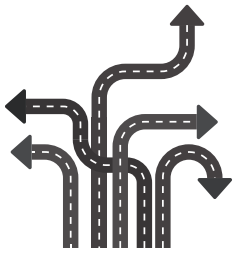
Our Motto

Our Students

The SCSTC provided home-to-school transportation for more than **36,000** students this year - a 4% increase from last year!



Transportation

SCSTC planned and coordinated transportation to over 150 schools on more than 720 school vehicle routes. Everyday, these routes travel over 63,000 kilometers. That's the equivalent to more than 1.6 times around the equator!



Delays

Any delay greater than 15 minutes is posted online and parents can subscribe to receive delay notifications. On average, 99.6% of SCSTC's total runs did **not** report a delay this year.



Inclement Weather

In 2018/19, the SCSTC had 25 Weather Review Calls due to inclement weather. This is an increase of 32% from last year! These calls resulted in 6 full county cancellations and 4 partial county cancellations.



Safety

The SCSTC is committed to student safety and in 2018/19 increased the number of safety programs available for students.

Students Trained:

- First Rider Program: **649 Students**
- *NEW* First Rider Program Specialized Transportation: **10 Students**
- Bus Tag Program: **5,171 Students**
- School Bus Evacuation Training (Fall): **25,360 Students**
- On-Site Safety Training Program: **23,066 Students**
- School Bus Evacuation Training (Spring): **24,883 Students**
