

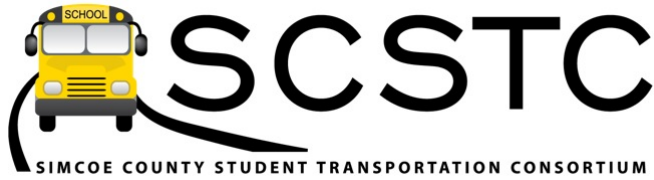

Rationale	The Simcoe County Student Transportation Consortium (SCSTC) policy for Transportation Eligibility identifies the parameters used to determine eligibility for home-to-school student transportation.
Policy	It is the policy of the SCSTC to follow Member District School Boards' policies and procedures to determine student transportation eligibility between home and school.
Overview	<p>In accordance with the SCSTC member district school boards policies and procedures, home-to-school student transportation eligibility is determined based on the student's primary address as identified by the school.</p> <p>Transportation services will be reflective of a partnership with the home, which prioritizes safety, equity, consistency and the efficient use of available resources.</p> <p>Transportation services may be provided between home and school to students who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ attend school in their designated school attendance area; ▪ have a primary address that is outside the schools established walk zone.

<p>Overview Continued...</p>	<p>The SCSTC will establish walking zones for each school using a digitized map, vehicle and/or a measuring wheel based on the following distances:</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="435 594 1495 669"> <tr> <td>Elementary Students</td> <td>1.6 kilometers</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Secondary Students</td> <td>3.2 kilometers</td> </tr> </table> <p>Measurements are taken from the student’s residential property line nearest to the closest entrance of the school property.</p> <p>The boundary of each walking zone will reflect the most direct and practical walking route from the home school to home.</p> <p>Approved transportation will be to/from SCSTC authorized bus stop locations only.</p> <p>Transportation may not be provided for students who by choice attend a school outside of their designated school boundary (out of attendance students).</p> <p>The SCSTC provides transportation to eligible students between home and school. The SCSTC does not provide transportation to extra-curricular activities, after school programs, after school employment, and/or the employment location of parent/guardian. Transportation to locations outside of home and school are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.</p>	Elementary Students	1.6 kilometers	Secondary Students	3.2 kilometers
