

year in review

A visual glimpse of the last twelve months during which the SCSTC remained focused on its Mission and Strategic Plan to provide safe, effective and efficient transportation to students in Simcoe County.

1. student transportation

This year, the SCSTC transported students to 150 schools on 708 routes. Every day, these routes travel approximately 57,337km. That is more than seven times the width of all of Canada!

Using GPS, the SCSTC improved tracking and reporting of vehicle on-time performance. This year, 99.6% of runs did NOT report a delay.

service level

The First Rider program was offered virtually this year and the video was viewed 790 times. Over 5,500 bus tags were created for students on both the full-size bus and specialized transportation to support students that required to be met.

student safety

The Ministerial Order to close all publicly funded schools in Ontario due to COVID-19 took effect in January and again in April. During this time, the SCSTC created value in uncertain times and provided additional value-added services to its MDSB and their students.
